

## Instrument of Delegation

### *Legal Profession Uniform Law Application Act 2014* *Legal Profession Uniform Law (Victoria)*

1. This instrument revokes all previous delegations conferred on the person for the time being holding, acting in or performing the duties of the position of **Senior Enquiries and Review Liaison/Senior Licensing and Early Resolution Liaison**, by the **Victorian Legal Services Board** (ABN 82 518 945 610) pursuant to section 44(1)(b) of the *Legal Profession Uniform Law Application Act 2014* (Vic) ("the Act").
2. Pursuant to section 44(1)(b) of the Act, the **Victorian Legal Services Board** hereby delegates to the person for the time being holding, acting in or performing the duties of the position of **Senior Resolution Advisor**, its functions, duties and powers hereinafter specified, subject to the conditions specified herein.
